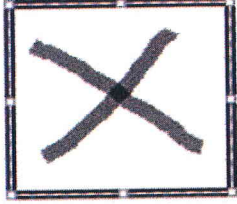

Stop the Education cuts!

Budget cuts at Birmingham City Council's Central Services mean that your children's school may lose the following services or have to pay a lot more for them:

Music Service	Outdoor Learning Service
Services for SEN children	Early Years' Teacher Support
Behaviour Support Service	Birmingham Advisory and Support Service
Education Action Zones	City Learning Centres
Support for supplementary schools	School and Governor support
Health Education Service	Catering and cleaning
Family Learning Service	International Office (school exchange)
Arts Education	Ethnic Minority Pupil Support

Our children are at risk of losing the vital experiences of learning at Birmingham museums, libraries, school farms or in outdoor settings forever. They are at risk of losing help with behaviour, decent school meals, expert training for teachers or being able to get a wider experience of sports and music.

We don't believe that these cuts have to happen. The Trades Union Congress has made clear that by tackling tax avoidance by the wealthy we can both reduce the deficit and have decent public services for all. Instead of implementing plans to cut our services, we urge Birmingham City Council to stand up for its children and staff by pressing the Government for more money.
