Vital learning experiences at Birmingham museums, libraries, school farms or in outdoor settings could be lost forever, as could help with behaviour, decent school meals, expert training for teachers or being able to get a wider experience of sports and music.

But these cuts don't have to happen. Tackling tax avoidance by the wealthy could reduce the deficit and pay for decent public services for all. A 'Robin Hood Tax' on banking transactions could also bring in £20 billion a year.
